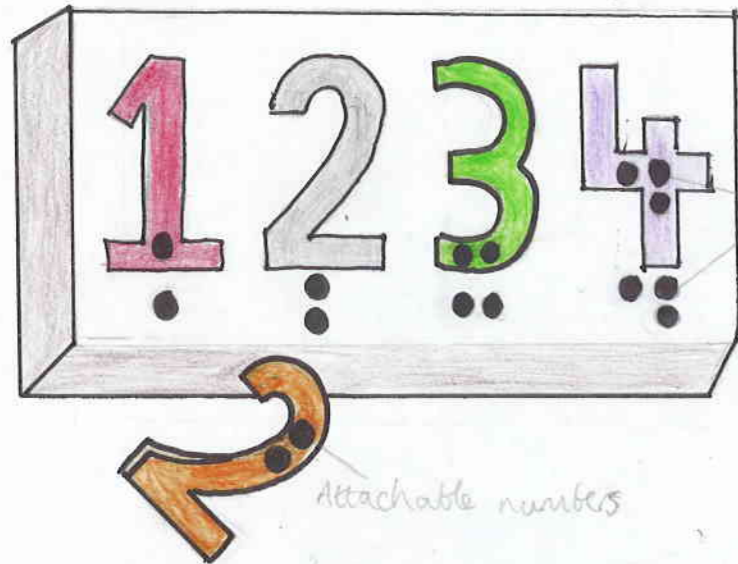


Design Ideas:

I have placed braille on both the wooden base and on the wooden numbers. So the blind people can link up the number to the appropriate slot.

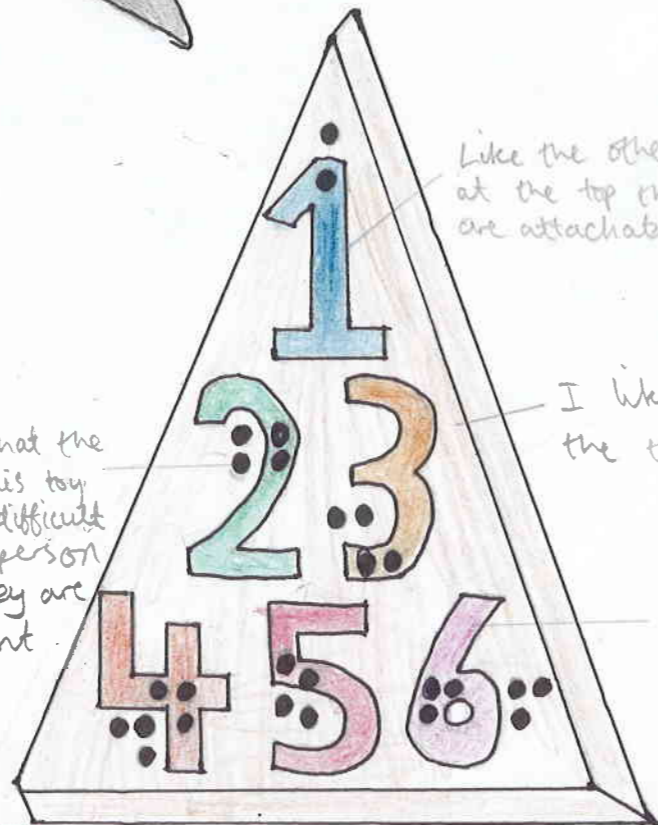
Although I like this idea I don't think I will carry it out.

I think that the braille on this toy may be more difficult for the blind person to find as they are jotted in different places.



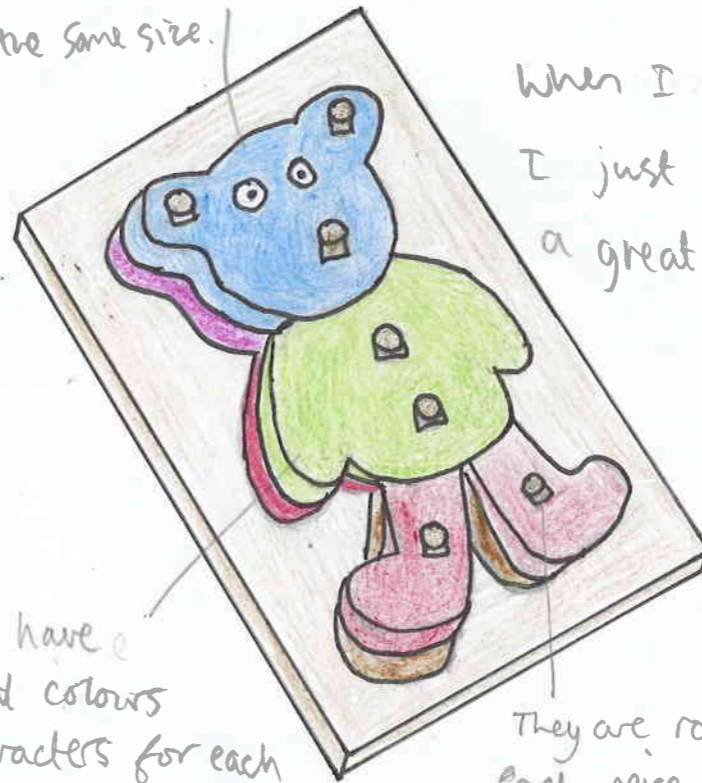
Like the other design at the top the numbers are attachable.
